Dear Parents/Carers

I hope you have all had a good few weeks. We have really got back into the swing of things again and the children have loved being back at swimming (in Classes 2 and 3), carrying out their new topic work, doing PE and Forest School.

Our new pupils have really settled in well and are used to the routines in school. Many thanks to parents who have helped them with the big change that they have experienced over the past couple of weeks.

The new pupil roles have started this week and the Pupil Leadership team supported me at Celebration Assembly yesterday. I look forward to working with them and the newly elected School Council.

Just a reminder that the school gate is now open every morning from **8.35**. Myself, Miss Timbrell or a teacher are always on the gate if you need to talk. The Children can come straight into their classrooms from this time. The gates are opened at **3.10** to allow parents into the playground to collect their children. **Butterflies** will gather in front of the inside gates leading to their classroom; **Kingfishers** will line up to the right-hand side of the front door (as you face the front door); **Otters** will line up to the left hand side of the front door.
